Genocide: The deliberate and systematic destruction of a racial, political, cultural or religious group.

Ghettos: Nazis' device of concentration and control, the compulsory "Jewish Quarter". Ghettos were established in the poor sections of a city, where most Jews were forced to reside.

Kippah: Skull cap worn by Jewish men. A kippah is worn to symbolize that man exists only from his kippah down; God exist above the kippah.

Anti-Semitism: Opposition to and discrimination against Jews.

Aryan: A term for peoples speaking the language of Europe and India. In Nazi racial theory, a person of pure German "blood".

Bystander: One who is present at some event without participating in it.

Concentration Camps: 1933-1945

Death Camps: Nazi extermination centers

Displacement: The process of people being involuntary moved from their homes.

Final Solution: A Nazi euphemism for the plan to exterminate other Jews of Europe.
