<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - want what is truly best for each other - are willing to let go of short-term pleasure to do what is kind and caring for the long term. - Bring out the best in each other 	Love is Kind	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -is scary, you worry about how they will react to what you say and do -threatens you -uses or weapons is violent, quick to anger, fights
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -are happy when the other is truly happy -celebrates each others achievements -respects each other's relationships 	Love is not envious	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jealous or possessive towards you. Won't let you have friends, -checks up on you won't accept the breakup
